

Note: The Positive cut-off will be 15 ng/L for females and 20 ng/L for males. The AMI cut-off will be 88 ng/L. The critical Value will be 150 ng/L. Only the first two values above the critical values on each patient will be called by the lab.

This document is meant to serve as a guideline and is NOT to replace clinical judgement. The diagnosis of Unstable Angina should be considered, even with normal hsTroponin.
